- 3.) Three (3) copies of a current zoning map for the property. These maps can be printed from the City of Chicago Zoning Department's webpage. If you have trouble with this site, please contact Alderman O'Shea's office at (773)238-8766.
- 4.) Determine the current zoning designation(s) of the site in question and the requested zoning designation. Once you have this, please complete the attached information chart to the best of your ability.
- 5.) Three (3) copies of a complete plan set, if available, for the committee to view. At a minimum, please have three (3) copies of a site plan and a floor plan of the proposed structure(s).
- 6.) A copy of the property survey.
- 7.) At least two (2) recent photos (one front and one rear) of the proposed site including adjacent structures.
- 8.) A copy of the condominium declaration if your project involves the construction of town homes or condominiums.
- 9.) If your project involves new construction, please furnish a copy of a Sid well Map showing property frontage.
- 10.) Any other materials you feel would support a zoning revision.

The Local Zoning Advisory Board evaluates all requests for zoning change and makes recommendations to the Alderman based on the potential community impact of any proposed change.
